Mount Union's second annual move out day benefit sale and recycling project, Clean the MUC, will be held from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Wednesday and 9 a.m. to noon Thursday at the Alpha Tau Omega house on Mount Union's campus.

This sale is open to the public and all proceeds will benefit area United Way agencies. Any remaining items will be disbursed to Goodwill, Habitat for Humanity, Alliance Food Pantry, YMCA, the Alliance Domestic Violence Shelter and the YWCA at the close of the sale.
